

## HERMETICA PHILOSOPHICA. ADDENDA ET CORRIGENDA

vol. I, p. 139 a. The siglum NNP is not clear, and the following editions are found in the Pierpont Morgan Library, as verified by Mr. Maurice Posada : 1503, 1512, 1516, 1554.

For the edition of 1505, delete the location USGS.

p. 141 a, line 34. Read : clientelam.

p. 145 a - b. Hermetica Philosophica II 1. De divinitate or Asclepius, translation attributed to Lucius Apuleius. In his learned review of volume I, Claudio Leonardi suggests that all manuscripts of this translation that were not used by its modern editors should be explicitly listed (*Bullettino dell'Istituto Storico Italiano per il Medio Evo e Archivio Muratoriano* 72, 1961, p. 268). In complying with his suggestion, we are using some of the data given by Leonardi himself.
